

Please find a summary of changes to the EU Reintegration Programme MO 2024:

<u>Post-Arrival Package request and implementation timeline</u>
- Extension of the Post-Arrival Package delivery from 3 working days to 14 working days
- Requirement for the submission of application 19 calendar days prior to TCN's arrival in order to deliver assistance on the day of arrival.
- Later submission of application and, therefore, delivery of the assistance is possible leaving time for implementation within 14 working days counted from arrival.
<u>Post-Arrival Package amount:</u>
- Post-Arrival Package unit costs set at 615 for VR and 205 FR regardless of the means of transportation.
<u>Clarification on the availability of post-arrival support for charter flights:</u>
- Restricted availability, information shared in a timely manner.
- Value of the Post-Arrival Package depends on type of return (VR vs FR).
<u>Clarification on KM1, KM2 and KM3 workflows</u>
- Updated design of workflow charts.
- Specification and clarifications on requirements for KM1, KM2 and KM3 (the written instructions that MS and RPs have received during the year has been adapted into the MO).
- Addition of a 5-month deadline for submission of the retroactive cases to allow time for processing and reintegration plan development.
<u>Data protection:</u>
- More detailed description of roles and responsibilities.
- Edited consent sheet to explicitly cover all the data in the application form. Note that the consent form is in the back of the application now.
- Updated Privacy notice for TCNs.
<u>Fundamental rights:</u>
- More detailed recommendations and complaint management.
<u>Other:</u>
- Added sensitive non-classified marking and distribution/handling instructions.
- Updated geographic coverage (35 countries).
