Application for marriage preparation procedure or for a certificate of legal capacity to marry

The application for a marriage preparation procedure or certificate of capacity to marry can be submitted by the engaged couple together on the same form, or individually on separate forms. The civil registry office where one of the couple has their place of residence is responsible for carrying out the preparatory procedure or issuing the certificate of capacity to marry. If both persons live abroad, the civil registry office that will perform the wedding ceremony in Switzerland is also responsible for the marriage preparation procedure. If a certificate of capacity to marry is required for a couple domiciled abroad, this should be issued by the civil registry office where one of the couple has their place of origin in Switzerland. Couples abroad may request their Swiss representation to forward their application to the relevant civil registry office in Switzerland on their behalf.

Find out in good time from your civil registry office or Swiss representation which **documents** you will need. The authorities reserve the right to ask for further documents or a fee for authentication. As a rule, documents that are not in an official Swiss language must be **translated**. Each person must attend the **marriage preparation procedure** and **civil ceremony** in person and bring **identification (passport or identity card)** as well as proof of residence.
